

# Utah's first commercial-scale wind project

In 2008, Spanish Fork Canyon will be home to Utah's first commercial-scale wind farm, featuring nine 2.1 megawatt Suzlon turbines (18.9 megawatt of installed wind capacity).

After several years of resource assessment and project negotiations, construction is finally underway and expected to be complete by summer 2008. Rocky Mountain

Power will purchase the energy output of the project.

Rocky Mountain Power Blue Sky customers will be supporting most of the renewable energy certificates. Participating in the Blue Sky program provides customers with an opportunity to help encourage and support the development of renewable energy resources in the region and close to home.
